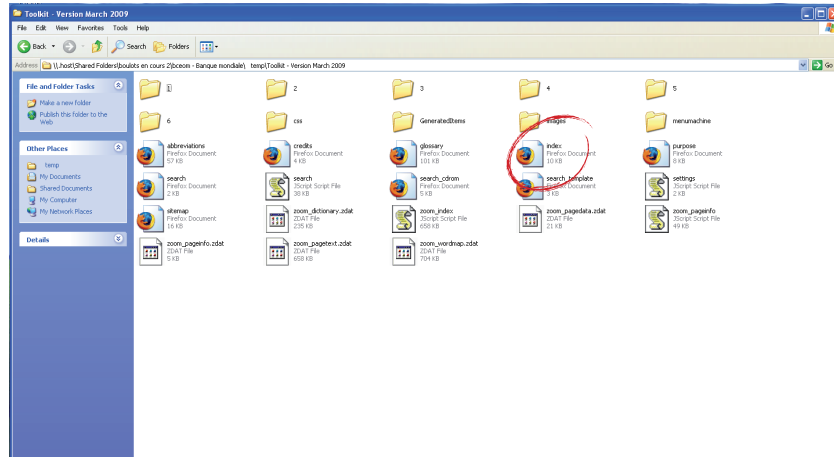


Instructions :

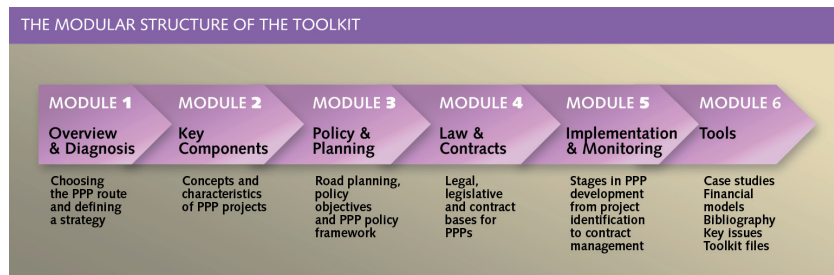
